Today, every single parish worldwide shares what they can so the life-transforming work of missionaries overseas can continue.

LIFE on Machair Project: information meeting in Killeen Community Centre on Monday 24 October, 7.00-9.00pm. Focusing on Natura 2000 areas. The EU funded LIFE on Machair project is a combined programme linking a number of agencies – the Dept. of Housing, Planning, Local Government and Heritage, the Dept. of Agriculture, Forestry and the Marine, Teagasc and Failte Ireland – that will run from 2022-2028. The focus of the project will be on developing appropriate agri-environment guidance for farming on coastal grassland and dune systems with farmers in the project areas, as well as development of sustainable tourism guidelines for communities and businesses. The project areas in the Killeen area are the Lough Cahasy, Lough Baun and Roonagh Lough SAC and the Dooagtry Machair system (part of the Mweelrea/Sheefry/Erriff Complex SAC). All are welcome.
