The Relics of St. Bernadette: As the Relics of St. Bernadette of Lourdes continue on their journey to the Dioceses of Ireland, they will be in the Archdiocese of Tuam next weekend with a visit to Knock on Sunday, 29 September and to Tuam Cathedral on Monday, 30 September.
