This beautiful Advent Tradition, Bambinelli Sunday, was renewed by Saint Pope John Paul II. The tradition follows that, on the Third

Sunday of Advent (Gaudete or Joyful Sunday), children and parents bring the Baby Jesus figures from their homes to St. Peter's Square, in Rome, where they are blessed by the Pope. Then the children will take them home to be placed under their Christmas trees.
